SPEAKERS

Hrvoje Njirić (Croatia) – the recipient of the Zagreb Salon Award (2000), the Grand Prix of Zagreb Salon (2003 and 2006), of UHA's *Drago Galić Award* (2000) and *Viktor Kovačić Award* (2000), *Piranesi Award* (2007). He was shortlisted for *Piranesi Award* in 2000 and *Mies van der Rohe Award* in 2009.

He is a lecturer and a visiting professor at the ETSAM Madrid, MIT Boston, EVDS Calgary, AF Ljubljana, FA Ferrara, Arkitektskolen Aarhus, FA Trieste, UofT Toronto, UVA Charlottesville, UofN Pamplona, TU Wien, and a full professor at TU Graz and FGAG Split. In the office njirić+, he deals with housing, tourist and public architecture, especially educational institutions, and urban planning;

David Chipperfield (UK) – the founder of the David Chipperfield Architects, the winner of the 2007 *Riba Stirling Award* and 2011 *Mies van der Rohe Awards* and *Deutscher Architekturpreis*;

Tezuka Architects (Japan) – Takahuru + Yui Tezuka, founders of the internationally acclaimed architectural office Tezuka Architects, authors of the famous circular Fuji Kindergarten;

studio nonstop (Bosnia and Herzegovina) – leading architectural studio based in Sarajevo, which was founded in 1999 by Igor Grozdanić and Sanja Galić;

Dean Skira & Ante Nikša Bilić (Croatia)

Dean Skira is an internationally awarded lighting designer. Ante Nikša Bilić – architect and publicist, co-founder and editor of Oris Magazine, founder of the Ante Murales Studio;

Arhitekti Počivašek Petranovič (Slovenia) – architectural office founded in Ljubljana in 2017 by Davorin Počivašek and Urban Petranovič;

SKROZ (Croatia) – award-winning architectural office founded in 2008 by Margita Grubiša, Marin Jelčić, Daniela Škarica and Ivana Žalac. They are the recipients of UHA's *Bernardo Bernardi Award*,

Ministry of Culture's *Vladimir Nazor Award*, and the latest in the series of nominations is the one for *Viktor Kovačić Award* for the most successful achievement in architecture in 2021;

NFO (Croatia) – architectural office founded in 2008 by Kata Marunica and Nenad Ravnić. In addition to competition awards, their projects have been recognized through nominations for annual awards of UHA, HKA and the annual *Mies Van Der Rohe Award*;

Daniel Monheim (Switzerland) – one of the partners in the Swiss architectural office Christ & Gantenbein. He manages the most challenging projects with an emphasis on the state-of-the-art BIM design;

Anton García-Abril (Spain) – one of the founders of the architectural office Ensamble Studio, a full professor at the Faculty of Architecture and Urbanism (MIT). He is the recipient of the Spanish Academy Research Prize;

Max Núñez (Chile) – founder of the architectural office Max Núñez Arquitectos based in Santiago. He is the winner of the Architectural Record's *Design Vanguard Award* in 2017 and the Wallpaper Magazine's *Design Award* in 2013, 2018 and 2000;

Cecilia Puga & Paula Velasco (Chile) – founders of the architectural office Cecilia Puga – Paula Velasco Arquitectura. Puga is a professor at the Department of Architecture at Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile (PUC); she is a jury member of LafargeHolcim Awards for Latin America in 2022. Velasco is also a professor at the Department of Architecture at Pontificia Universidad Católica and was a manager of the architectural residency of London Festival in 2014;

Iva Letilović & Igor Pedišić (Croatia) – founders of the architectural office AB Forum, winners of the annual *Viktor Kovačić Award* for the most successful achievement in architecture (UHA) for the reconstruction project of the Governor's palace in Zadar. They are also the recipients of the *Vladimir Nazor Award* for the best artistic achievement in architecture awarded by the Ministry of Culture.
